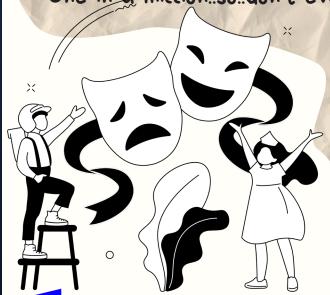




CHAMPION

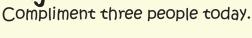

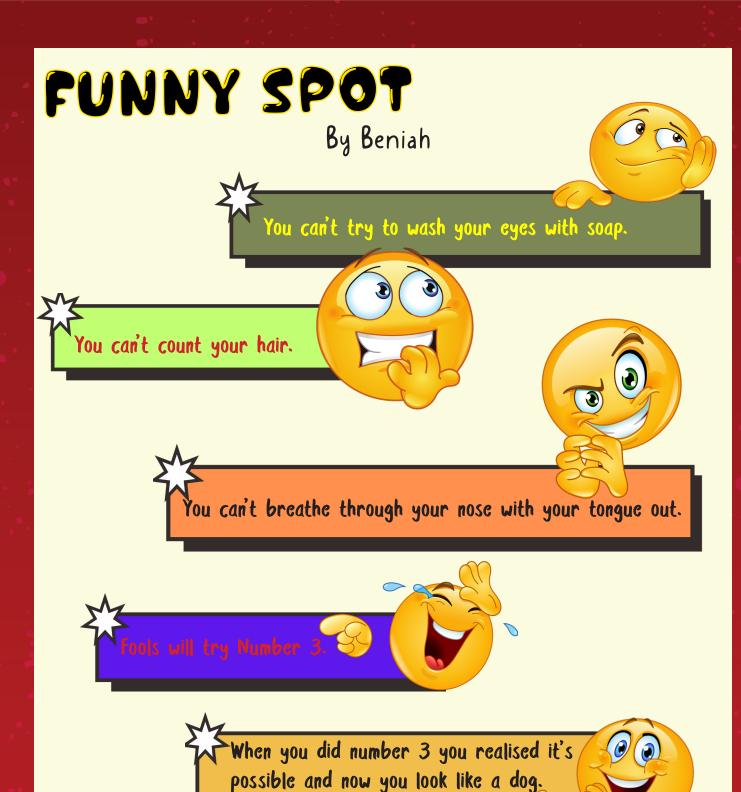
