Oversized Shirt or Sweater: For colder days, you can wear an oversized shirt or sweater for that comfy, cozy vibe.

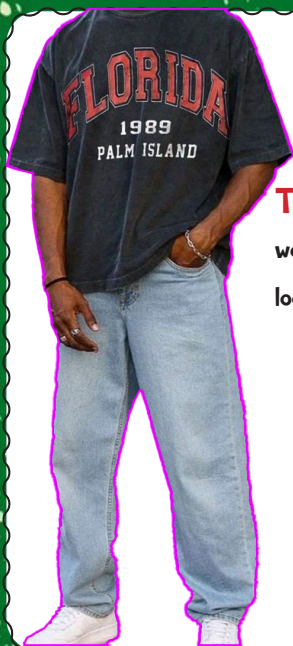
Chunky Sneakers or Sandals: Pair with chunky sneakers for a streetwear look or opt for flat sandals to keep things relaxed.

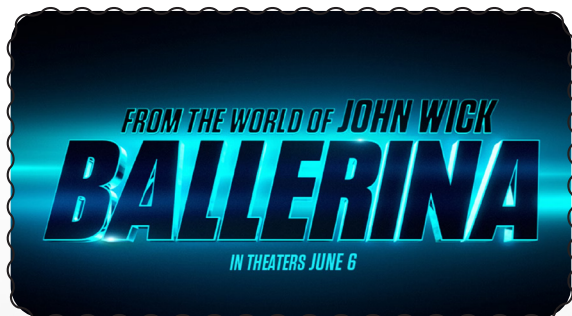

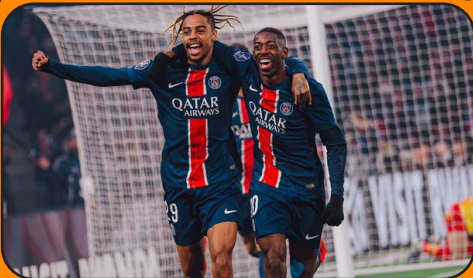
